NAMRIA ISO Core Team attends DAP training in Tagaytay City



NAMRIA went one step farther in its goal to develop its Quality Management System (QMS) certifiable to ISO 9001:2008 with the training held on ISO 9001:2008 QMS/Government QMS Requirements and Documentation. The training was conducted by personnel from the Development Academy of the Philippines (DAP) at the DAP Conference Center in Tagaytay City on 21-23 September 2011. The participants from NAMRIA were Deputy Administrators Linda S.D. Papa and Efren P. Carandang, who is the Agency's Quality Management Representative (QMR); along with Deputy QMR John Santiago F. Fabic; the other members of the NAMRIA's ISO Core Team; and facilitators from the Agency's Personnel Management and Development Section. The DAP Project Team for

the training was composed of Ms. Ivy A. Lecitona, Project Manager/Course Facilitator; Ms. Racquel M. Barbecho, Technical Consultant/Lecturer; Ms. Angela C. Vargas, Technical Consultant/Lecturer; and Ms. Sharona P. Lulu, Course Facilitator.

The scope and coverage of the three-day course featured the following modules: (1) NAMRIA Process Walkthrough Outputs, (2) NAMRIA QMS, (3) Introduction to QMS, (4-8) General and Documentation Requirements, and (9) The NAMRIA ISO 9001:2008 Certification. The next scheduled activity is a technical guidance session on drafting NAMRIA's Quality Policy, Quality Objectives, Higher-Level Process Model, among others.
