NAVPHIL 041/20 – LUZON, W. COAST, MANILA BAY – PORT CLOSURE

IN CONNECTION TO THE PRESIDENTIAL PROCLAMATION NO. 922 DECLARING A STATE OF PUBLIC HEALTH EMERGENCY THROUGHOUT THE PHILIPPINES AND THE PLACEMENT OF METRO MANILA UNDER COMMUNITY QUARANTINE, ALL PORTS IN METRO MANILA ARE CLOSED TO ALL DOMESTIC PASSENGER VESSELS INCLUDING PASSENGER MOTORBANCAS STARTING AT 08:00 AM OF 14 MARCH 2020. PHILIPPINE AUTHORITIES WILL NOT ALLOW ANY DOMESTIC PASSENGER DOMESTIC VESSELS TO DEPART OR CALL AT ANY PORT IN METRO MANILA. THE PORT CLOSURE WILL BE IN EFFECT UNTIL THE PHILIPPINE GOVERNMENT LIFT THE DECLARED COMMUNITY QUARANTINE OVER METRO MANILA.

ALL SHIPS/WATERCRAFTS ARE ADVISED TO TAKE NOTE OF THE INFORMATION AND ABIDE BY THE RULES SET BY THE PHILIPPINE GOVERNMENT TO PREVENT THE SPREAD OF COVID19.

MASTERS OF VESSELS WISHING TO CALL AT METRO MANILA ARE ADVISED TO CONTACT THE PORT AUTHORITIES OF THE PORT OF MANILA FOR FURTHER GUIDANCE.
