**NAVPHIL 043/20 – MINDORO, E. COAST, ORIENTAL MINDORO PROVINCE  
– PORT CLOSURE**

IN CONNECTION TO THE PRESIDENTIAL PROCLAMATION NO. 922 DECLARING A STATE OF PUBLIC HEALTH EMERGENCY THROUGHOUT THE PHILIPPINES AND ORIENTAL MINDORO PROVINCE EXECUTIVE ORDER 22-2020, ALL PASSENGERS OF MARINE VESSELS WILL NOT BE ALLOWED TO DISEMBARK AT ANY PORT IN THE PROVINCE OF ORIENTAL MINDORO FROM 14 TO 25 MARCH 2020. EXCLUDED IN THE ORDER ARE MEDICAL PROFESSIONALS AND GOVERNMENT PERSONNEL WHO WILL BE REQUIRED TO UNDERGO HEALTH PROTOCOLS LAID BY THE PHILIPPINE GOVERNMENT. CARGO VESSELS ARE ALSO ALLOWED TO DOCK AT ORIENTAL MINDORO PORTS TO LOAD AND UNLOAD CARGOES PROVIDED THAT THEY WILL FOLLOW THE HEALTH PROTOCOLS.

ALL SHIPS/WATERCRAFTS ARE ADVISED TO TAKE NOTE OF THE INFORMATION AND ABIDE BY THE RULES SET BY THE PHILIPPINE GOVERNMENT TO PREVENT THE SPREAD OF COVID19.

MASTERS OF VESSELS WISHING TO CALL AT ANY PORT IN ORIENTAL MINDORO ARE ADVISED TO READ THE FULL TEXT OF ORIENTAL MINDORO PROVINCE EXECUTIVE ORDER 022-2020 AND CONTACT THE PORT AUTHORITIES OF THE PORTS IN ORIENTAL MINDORO FOR FURTHER GUIDANCE.
