NAVPHIL 046/20 – PALAWAN, NE. COAST, CALAMIAN ISLANDS, PORT OF CORON – PORT CLOSURE

IN CONNECTION TO THE PRESIDENTIAL PROCLAMATION NO. 922 DECLARING A STATE OF PUBLIC HEALTH EMERGENCY THROUGHOUT THE PHILIPPINES AND CORON MUNICIPALITY ADVISORY, ALL DOMESTIC SEA TRAVEL, INCLUDING FOREIGN VESSELS ENTERING CORON, ARE SUSPENDED FROM 15 MARCH 2020 TO 14 APRIL 2020. VESSELS EXCLUDED TO THE SUSPENSION ARE THOSE TRAVELLING DUE TO HEALTH REASONS, DELIVERY OF FOOD SUPPLY, AND IMMEDIATE PURPOSE.

ALL SHIPS/WATERCRAFTS ARE ADVISED TO TAKE NOTE OF THE INFORMATION AND ABIDE BY THE RULES SET BY THE PHILIPPINE GOVERNMENT TO PREVENT THE SPREAD OF COVID19.

MASTERS OF VESSELS WISHING TO CALL AT THE MUNICIPALITY OF CORON ARE ADVISED TO READ THE FULL TEXT OF CORON MUNICIPALITY ADVISORY AND CONTACT THE PORT AUTHORITIES OF THE PORT OF CORON FOR FURTHER GUIDANCE.
